Tengo los ojos azules	I have (blue) eyes
Tengo el pelo negro	I have (black) hair
Es alto / alta	He is tall / She is tall
Es pequeño / Es pequeña	He is small / she is small
Es Delgada / Es gorda	She is slim. / She is fat
Es calvo	He is bald
Lleva gafas	She wears glasses
Tiene un bigote / tiene una barba	He has a moustache / he has a beard
Mis ojos son azules	My eyes are blue
Los ojos	eyes
El pelo	Hair
No tiene el pelo negro	He doesn't have black hair

COLOURS & STYLES:

To describe the colour of eyes – remember the “adjective” always goes after the noun. It also agrees with the noun (los ojos = plural).



To describe hair style & colour, the adjective comes after the noun. It also agrees with the noun (el pelo = masculine).

ADJECTIVES:

Adjectives describe nouns. Their endings change to agree with the noun they describe. Adjectives fall into 3 main groups:

Ending in **-o** or **-a** Ending in **-e** Ending in a **consonant**

	singular		plural	
	masculine	feminine	masculine	feminine
ending in -o	pequeño	pequeña	pequeños	pequeñas
ending in -e	inteligente	inteligente	inteligentes	inteligentes
ending in a consonant	azul	azul	azules	azules

Common Adjectives: (remember to change their endings to match the noun that they describe!!!)

Comodo – comfortable	incómodo - uncomfortable
Antiguo – old	nuevo -new
Pequeño – small	Grande – large
Bonito – pretty	Feo – ugly
Moderno – modern.	pasado de moda – old fashioned
Interesante – interesting	aburrido - boring
