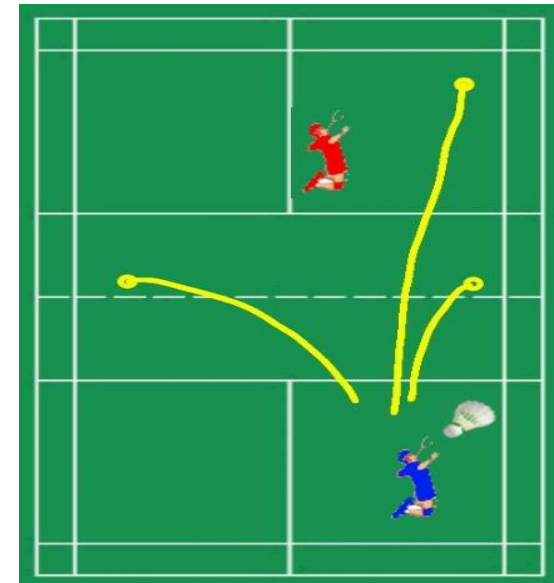

KEY VOCABULARY

Flick and underarm serve (Development)	A serve in which you make contact with the back of the racket or underarm from low to high.
Underarm clear (Development)	A shot played with the racket below your waist, which travels to the back of the court.
Overhead clear (Development)	A shot played with the racket above your head, which travels to back of the court.
Introduce the drop shot technique	A shot that travels over the net and lands close over the net on your opponents side
Introduce the smash shot	The smash shot is an attacking shot that is played directly to the floor of your opponent.
Tactics	A plan to outwit an opponent, or gain an advantage to try to beat them.



KEY QUESTIONS

- What would you expect to see from a good smash?
- Where would you find space on a singles/doubles court, in which to direct the shuttle to beat an opponent?
- What tactics would you use to move an opponent out of position on court?
- What shots would you use at the front and back of the court?
