KEY VOCABULARY

Fielding techniques <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One pick up • Recall Long Barrier 	One handed pick up is picking the ball up on the move and throwing underarm at the target in one movement. Long Barrier is using your leg to stop a fast travelling ball that is going into the fielding team.
Grip	How you hold the bat
Batting-Drive shot	Hitting the ball as an attacking shot to try to score runs
Batting- Pull shot	Hitting the ball as an attacking shot to try to score runs and pulling the ball away from the wickets
Bowling Development	Improving the consistency of bowling the ball at the wickets making the batter play a shot.
Batting tactics	The batter varying where they hit the ball to try to score runs
