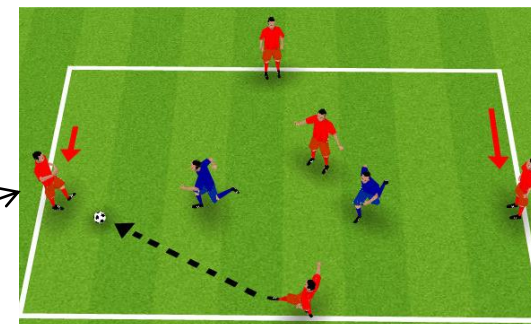

KEY VOCABULARY

PASSING (Under pressure)	Passing the ball to another team mate using the inside part of the foot, when increased pressure from a defender
DRIBBLING AND TURNING (Under pressure)	Moving with the ball under control and changing the direction of movement with the ball, when under increased pressure from a defender
SHOOTING (Under Pressure)	Kicking the ball towards the goal to score and gain an advantage, when under increased pressure from a defender.
HEADING	Using the head to make contact with the ball, when heading at goal or when defending the goal .
4 V 2 ATTACKING PLAY	When 4 attackers try to score against 2 defenders, an overload situation.
Strategies and tactics defensive – Jockeying	A defensive method used when attempting to tackle an attacker.
