KEY VOCABULARY

PASSING (Timing of)	To be able to outwit opponents using a variety of passes with accuracy and timing when under an increased pressure from a defender
ATTACKING PLAY/OUTWITTING OPPONENTS (Under pressure)	To be able to demonstrate good positioning whilst dodging to allow effective attacking strategies when under increased pressure from a defender
MARKING/DEFENDING	To mark and intercept any passes using first stage of defending(close marking) followed by second stage defending (defending in front of a player)
FREE PASS	When a rule is broken that does not directly affect another player e.g. footwork, lost possession, held ball
PENALTY PASS	The offending player who has either obstructed or made contact with another player must stand out of the way until the pass is taken

- How can the speed of the pass gain the advantage in the game?
- What should an attacking player do to keep possession of the ball?
- How can footwork keep the game flowing?
- How can the defender dominate the space the attacker can take?
