Dear Parent/carer,

Following the HM Government announcement about the tougher measures needed to restrict COVID-19 transmission, I am writing to inform you that the school will not be providing on-site education with immediate effect until further notice. Most children will not be in school.

The only exceptions to this are children of key workers or those whose circumstances make them vulnerable. You should have let us know already if your child is in one of these groups.

For all other children, we will continue to provide remote learning as planned. We have already written to you letting you know how this will operate. We are very sorry to have to let you know about this and at such short notice. We are following HM Government and Public Health England guidance as are all other schools in England.
